

# Hairwing Caddis



## Recipe and Tying Steps

1. Dry fly hook, #12-18, thread color to match fly, 6/0 or 8/0
2. Lay a bed of thread.
3. Dub body with desired caddis color (green, olive, cinnamon, tan, black, etc.). Synthetic material will float better.
4. Tie one hackle in the thorax, color to match the natural. Hackle barbs should be about one-and-one-half times the width of the hook gape. Apply head cement to thorax.
5. Make 2-8 wraps of the hackle through the thorax.
6. Shape a head, tie off using your favorite knot, and add head cement
