



Cased Caddis

Hook: 2x or 3x nymph hook, size 14-18

Thread: Black, 6/0

Wire: .030"

Body (caddis head): Bright Green Chenille, Brown/Black Varigated Chenille

Legs: Partridge hackle

Body: Natural hare's ear dubbing (keep the guard hairs) in dubbing loop

Head: Tying thread

Tying Instructions:

1. Start your thread on the hook shank leaving an eye-length space behind the eye. Take wraps rearward to about the 1/3 point.
2. Tie in the Green Chenille and take a single wrap of the chenille and tie it off.
3. Tie in the Partridge hackle and take a single turn and tie it off.
4. Tie in the Brown Chenille and take a single wrap of the chenille and tie it off.
5. Heavily weight the center of the body with .030" wire. Secure and wrap back up to the chenille.
6. Form a dubbing loop using the Hare's Ear dubbing and wrap over the wire to form the body and tie off.
7. Do a 4-5 turn whip finish and snip your thread off close.

Notes:

This fly is intended to be fished on the bottom with a very slow retrieve to imitate a crawling cased caddis.
